Lord Rayleigh 1878

Linearization around a uniform state $\nabla \overline{a} \approx 0$,

Mean flow velocity neglected in front of the sound speed $\overline{\mathbf{u}}.\nabla \approx 0$

Admittance & transfer function

Flame propagating in a tube

thickness of the flame brush \ll acoustic wavelength

gas expansion \Rightarrow jump of the fluctuations of the flow velocity (acoustics)

$$(\delta u_b - \delta u_u)/U_L = O(1)$$



laser tomography (Boyer 1980)

jump of pressure across the flame brush is negligible

acoustic pressure $\delta p = \rho a \delta u$ $(\delta p_b - \delta p_u)/p = O(U_L/a)$ δp_f : fluctuation of the pressure at the flame $p/\rho a^2 = O(1)$

averaged (per period) flux of combustion energy transferred to the acoustic waver

$$\dot{\mathcal{E}}_t = \overline{(\delta u_b - \delta u_u)\delta p_f}$$

mass conservation (quasi-isobaric combustion)
